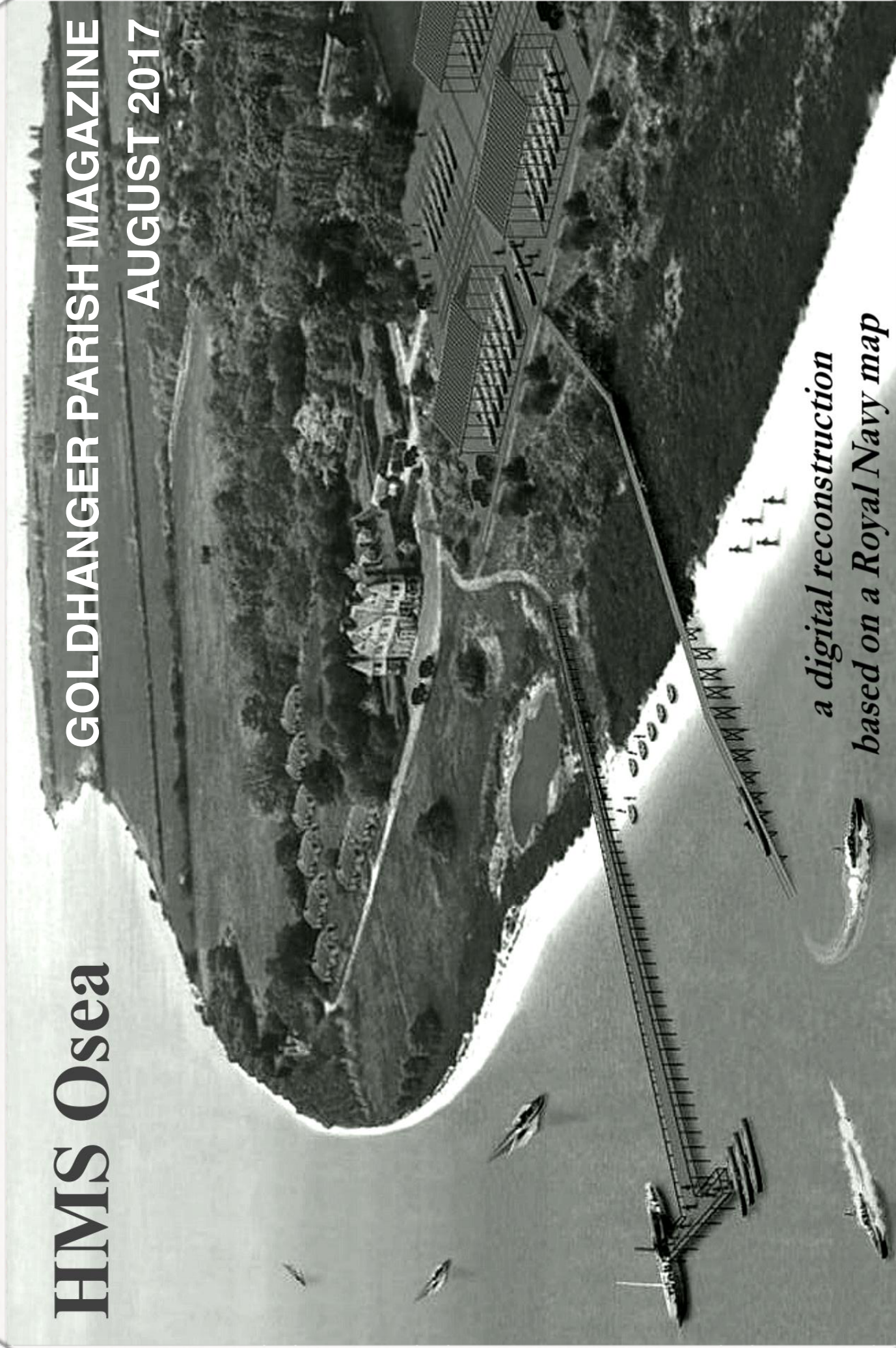

Osea Island's links with Goldhanger

There have been many connections between Goldhanger and Osea Island in the past. One theory is that the north-south route of Church St, Fish St and Bounds farm track was once part of a straight Roman road connecting the island with Colchester which was lost when sea levels rose. Goldhanger is still the nearest village to the island by boat. The island has had many previous owners. In the 1700s it was owned by the same family who were Lords of the Manor to Goldhanger who lived in Vaulty Manor.

In the 1880s Dr Salter took Prince Nicholas, later the Tsar Nicholas, shooting on Osea island at the request of Queen Victoria, and afterwards they had lunch at The Chequers Inn.

In 1903 Frederick Charrington, heir to the London Brewery dynasty, bought the island and developed it into a resort and "Cure for Inebriety". He published a booklet in 1907 entitled: "Osea island - The New Temperance Seaside Resort". Bizarrely the booklet has in it this picture of The Chequers !

It is said that so much alcohol was smuggled onto the island by boat by customers of the Chequers that the resort became ineffective. Mr Charrington even employed Goldhanger curate Douglas Vale as the island's hotel manager, but he later died of alcoholism!

During WW-1 the navy took over the island and developed "HMS Osea" a huge Coastal Motor Boat (CMB) base with accommodation for 1000 personnel. Several Goldhanger residents were employed there. After the war a Heybridge Basin company were employed to move the huts. Many were moved to Heybridge where they remain and a few came to Goldhanger.

In 1981 the BBC made a television programme about the island's history and several Goldhanger residents who once lived or worked on the island took part and recalled their experiences while sitting in The Chequers. Jack and Mary Hulbert, landlords at the time, also took part and related how customers from the island would sleep on the floor when they missed the tide.

For many years Goldhanger postman, the late Kenny Chaplin, made the daily journey over the Causeway on his bicycle to collect and deliver the mail.

Former Goldhanger resident and journalist Joe Canning published a semi-biographical novel in 2006 entitled: Once upon an Island which is based on the many Osea Island - Goldhanger connections.

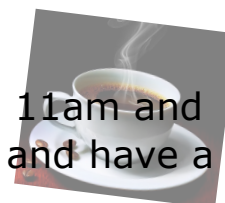

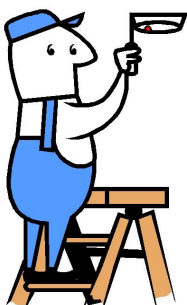

Honouring those killed in the Great War recorded on our memorial.

This is being done by raising the Union Flag on the Church on the 100th anniversary of their death and ringing the bells for a short time during that day.

Two young men from Goldhanger were killed in August 1917.

William Hummerston and Allan Seaborn who died in the area called the Ypres Salient. This salient containing the ruins of the town of Ypres which was taken by the British in 1914 and remained in our hands, stuck out of the trench line for the whole of the war and was the scene of three major offensives. The third battle of Ypres later called Passchendaele took place between June and November 1917 and was one of the bloodiest of the war, taking place in the worst conditions ever fought in.

We do not have a great deal of information about William Hummerston who did not originally come from Goldhanger, but was married to Dick Phillips sister. (Dick is another of the names on our memorial and was the subject of an article in our magazine in April 2014). William was a Lance Corporal in the 16th battalion the Welsh Regiment; he was killed on 1st August 1917 and is buried in Ypres Reservoir Cemetery. Both Martin Gebel and myself have visited the cemetery at different times, which is in a quiet residential road in the outskirts of Ypres.

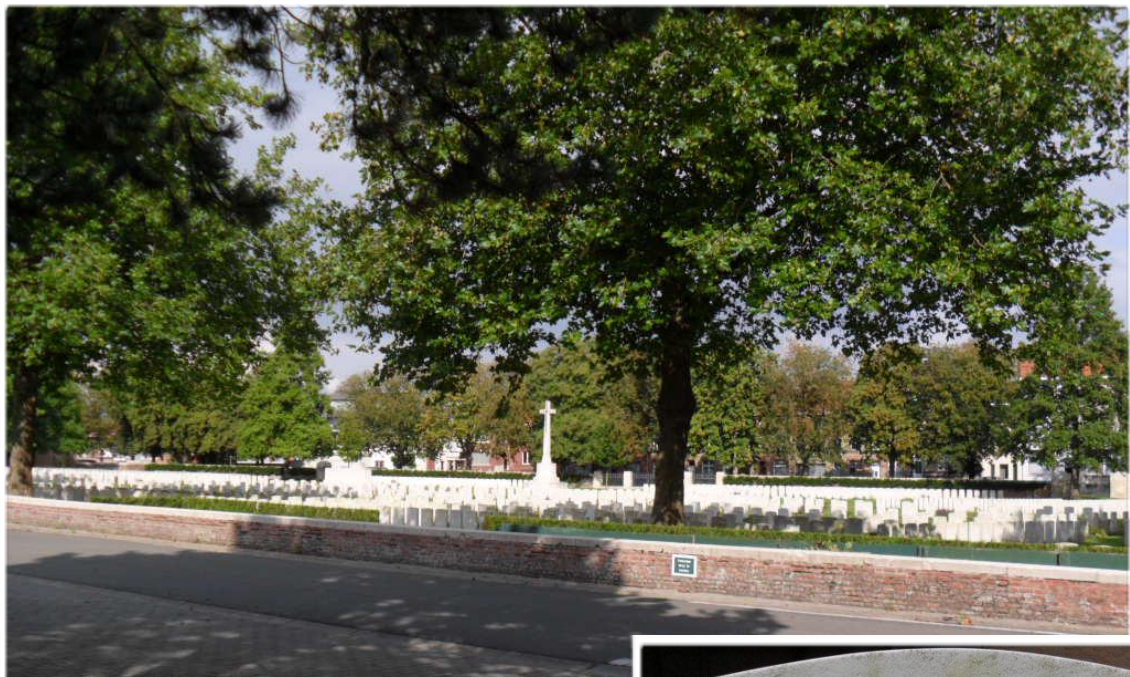
Rifleman Allan James Seaborn of the London Regiment (Queen Victoria's Rifles) was aged 21 and the son of Joseph and Alma Seaborn of Bakers Green and at one time Fish Street. He was killed on 13th August 1917.

Allan also had a brother called William who was in the Navy and was wounded at the battle of Jutland in 1916.

Allan is commemorated on panel 54 of the famous Menin Gate which remains one of the entrances into the town of Ypres.

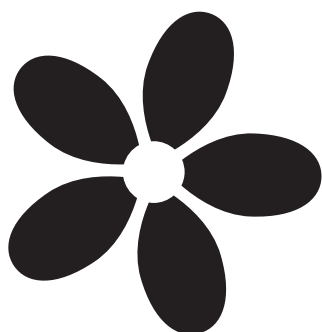


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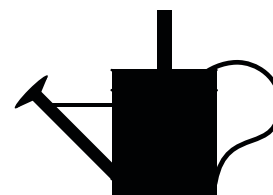

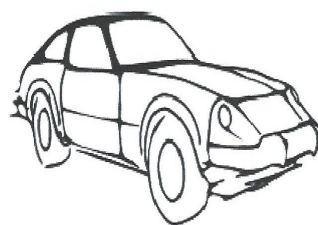

GOLDHANGER PARISH COUNCIL

Report on the Ordinary Meeting held on 11.7.2017

The overgrown grass on the triangles at Lt Totham Rd/Maldon Rd and Church St/Maldon Rd have been reported to Highways several times. The former has now been cut but the grass on the latter is causing visibility problems to drivers and will be reported again.

Planning

The following decisions by Maldon District Council were noted:

Hofflands Little Totham Road – claim for a Lawful Development Certificate for the existing use of continued occupation in excess of 10 years as a dwelling – **approved**.

Land rear of 60 Maldon Road Goldhanger – Variation of condition 2 of approved application (change of use of land and proposed development of four 5 bedroom detached dwellings with detached/attached garages, together with access drive from new adjoining development) – **approved**.

There were no new applications to consider.

The Maldon District Local Development Plan (with modifications) has been declared sound by the Planning Inspector and has now gone to the Secretary of State for approval.

Highways

The damaged sign outside Lilac Cottage on Maldon Road is not considered by Highways as in need of action/repair. However, the Parish Council will report it again as a safety issue.

The parking restrictions in Fish Street are now in place but it was noted that there have been some infringements. The Council will consider asking Maldon District Council's Community Watch Scheme to visit the area and deal with any vehicles unlawfully parked.

Internal auditor's report

The Council considered the internal auditor's report on the accounts for the year ended 31.3.2017, and the issues raised have been addressed.

Playing field

The bench in the playing field is in need of repair work and the Council will take action to get this done.

Defibrillators

A seminar to provide information on the defibrillators was held on 3rd July 2017 and was well attended. The defibrillators will be installed on 19th July.

The October meeting of the Parish Council will now be held on the third Tuesday of the month (17th) as a number of Councillors will be on holiday for the usual date.

The next meeting of the Parish Council will be held on Tuesday 8th August 2017. All are welcome to attend, and the agenda will be published on the Council's website

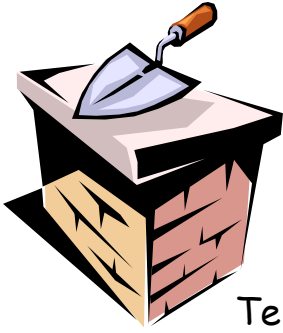

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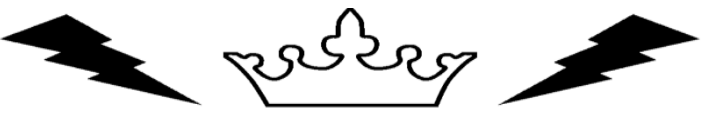
