#### The Bellringer's Trophies

Congratulations to the Goldhanger Bellringers for winning the South Eastern district annual striking competition which was held at Burnham on the 3rd of June and so brought home the coveted Bellringer's trophy. The trophy has a particular significance to the village as it is one of two prizes that were constructed many years ago to honour two local ringers who were both well known throughout Essex as accomplished ringers. The one that has come home is Ernie Johnson trophy which is shown on the left of the front cover. To the best of our knowledge neither trophy has been won and returned home for at least 40 years!



Here are some extracts from letter in our records dated 2008 from the then Danbury Tower Captain Joe Roast...

"I knew Ernest Johnson very well and rung many peals with him during the 1950s and 60s. He was a bachelor Who lived by himself in Fish Street. He made many contributions to the fund for restoring the Goldhanger Bells and was a very generous character. He died in November 1976 aged 64 years and is buried in Goldhanger Churchyard. During the restoration work in 1952 much of

the old oak frame was made into fundraising objects. One of those was a bell shaped bedside lamp which Ernie purchased and gave to me. After his death it was adapted to become the call change trophy. When the bells were augmented to eight I rang many peals with Ernie. On those occasions he arranged a ham supper afterwards in the Chequers and always footed the bill. Ernie was somewhat of a loner but always reliable and a good ringer. He rang 130 peals".

The other trophy was constructed in honour of Arthur Appleton (1886-1971). He also lived all of his life in the village, was a member of a large Goldhanger family and had eleven siblings. For much of that time he worked on Hall Farm and tended to the milking cows and horses. During WW-1 he was a village special constable.

As an accomplished bell ringer Arthur was also well known in the district and the trophy would have been made after his death. It could well have been constructed by his son Geoff who was a carpenter in the village. His other son Harry was also a well know ringer.

Embedded within the trophy is a silver medallion that was presented to Arthur by the Revd. Gardner. One assumes that other ringers would have been given one at that time.





There are no details of the June Meeting as it had been postponed until after the magazine had gone to press.

#### **July Ministry Team Message**

Although you won't read this until July, I am actually writing it in the last week of May in order to make the copy deadline! I am struck at the moment by the weather. (Aren't we always in Britain!) It will be a distant memory by July so to remind you, it's been really odd! It can't make up it's mind whether it wants to rain, blow a gale, fry us with extra hot sun or chill us to the bone every evening as the temperature plummets! I saw on Facebook the other day a post which said "I know why this month is called May – it's because it *may* rain, it *may* be sunny, it *may* be windy or it *may* snow!"

As I was pondering what to write it occurred to me that we can be rather like the weather in our relationship with God. How so you may ask? In our spiritual lives we often just can't seem to make up our minds. Do we believe in God or don't we? Do we believe Jesus died for our sins or not? Is there life after death? How did the earth come into being – maybe through the "big bang" but who or what created that?

At times of joy we praise God raising our arms up to Him as we raise them up to the sun. We bask in the warmth of his glory. At times of difficulty or sadness, the world can feel cold, God can seem distant, hidden by storm clouds. And then there's the in between times when it's all a bit grey and damp and it's not terrible but it's not fabulous either. Sometimes that's when doubts creep in or we become disinterested, non-commital, even bored with God. Or to use a modern term we just feel a bit "meh."

How can we keep ourselves on a more even keel as we journey through life? Human beings are creatures of habit and it's often our regular habits that keep us going on a day to day basis. We can't always be full of joy – there will be highs in all our lives and thank God for them. There will be times of deep sorrow and sometimes those are the times when habits can be particularly comforting. On the day that my late husband was told that he had incurable Cancer we came out of the hospital in shocked silence. We had intended to go food shopping after the appointment and I thought my husband wouldn't want to after hearing such news, but he said "no let's go shopping, I just want to do something normal." So we did. Habits can be comforting. It is our routines and habitual activities that make up most of our lives.

So what are our spiritual habits? Do we have any? One very valuable spiritual habit is going to church. Having a regular rhythm of attending a church service is a really good way of bringing God into your life and not only do you get to spend time with God, there's always tea and coffee afterwards so you get an opportunity for a social chat as well. Some people think that sitting through a church service, saying the same words week in and week out must be boring, but actually it's the very repetition that helps us. It's a habit, but a good one. Sometimes we don't know what to say when we pray, but if we are saying the prayers in the service then we are praying and as the words become more familiar to us they become more meaningful. The ritual carries us and there is spiritual power in the prayers of a group of people all praying the same thing at the same time.

So come and join us and get into the habit of God. God bless you,







## Recipe of the month

#### Sausage, squash and apple traybake

#### Serves 6

**Time** Prep under 30 minutes, cook 10-30 minutes


#### Ingredients

- 1 small butternut squash, about 750g/1lb 10oz
- 2 red onions, sliced into rings
- 2 apples, unpeeled, cored and sliced
- 12 pork sausages
- 3 tbsp olive oil
- 1 tbsp runny honey
- 1 tsp English mustard
- salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 15g/½oz fresh flatleaf parsley, finely chopped, to garnish (optional)



- 1. Preheat the oven to 220C/200C Fan/Gas 7.
- 2. Cut the squash into quarters and leave it unpeeled. Remove the seeds then cut each quarter into 5mm/¼in slices.
- 3. Place the squash a very large baking tray with the onion, apple and sausages. Drizzle with 1 tablespoon oil and season well with salt and pepper. Roast for 20 minutes.
- Meanwhile, whisk together the honey, mustard and remaining oil in a small bowl. Drizzle over the sausages and vegetables and turn to coat everything in the dressing.
- 5. Return to the oven for 10 minutes until the sausages are browned and cooked through and the vegetables are tender. Sprinkle over the parsley, if using, and serve.
